Majestic “ Big Bend Country ”

The Hometown Travelers have planned a tour to the majestic **Big Bend Country** of West Texas. Many of you have been requesting that we do this tour again so here is a Springtime adventure to perhaps the most scenic and mountainous area of our own great state. This tour will require a fair amount of walking plus, some of our rooms may be on the second floor at the properties we will be staying at with no elevators.

Established in 1944 by Franklin Roosevelt, Big Bend National Park encompasses more than 800,000 acres. Despite its great size and amazing sights, Big Bend is one of the nation's least visited National Parks. Elevations within the park range from 1,800 feet near the Rio Grande on the eastern edge of the park to over 7,800 feet high in the Chisos Mountains. Such great disparity in elevation brings about a wide variety of ecosystems, from dry scrublands to cool mountain pine forests. The Rio Grande forms not only the park boundary, but also the international border on its 188 mile course through the park. Along the way, the Rio Grande cuts three massive limestone canyons, the Boquillas, Mariscal, and Santa Elena Canyons.

The majesty of the area doesn't stop with the breathtaking canyons; a violent volcanic past shaped the central area of the park, forming majestic peaks, deep canyons, and rocky spires. Big Bend National Park boasts more types of birds, bats, and cacti than any other national park in the United States. Words can not describe what Big Bend really is, only a trip out here will do that for you.

On our **first day**, we'll motorcoach from East Texas to Columbus for lunch and on through the Texas Hill Country to Kerrville for the night. Late afternoon we'll visit “**The Coming King**” Sculpture Prayer Gardens overlooking Kerrville. **Day two**, continue west with lunch in Fort Stockton and then south into the beautiful Davis Mountains to our home for the night, Fort Davis. On **Day three**, we will begin with a daylight tour of the Observatory with lunch at the Star Date Cafe. We'll then travel to Presidio and begin our trek along the scenic River Road with **Lajitas Resort & Spa**, our destination & home for the next two nights.

Our **fourth day** begins with a stop at the Desert Garden Center where we will pick up our guide for the day of touring **Big Bend National Park**. Lunch will be at the **Chisos Mountain Lodge** offering a magnificent view of “**The Window**” with afternoon touring in **Santa Elena Canyon**. Late afternoon we arrive in Terlingua for dinner at the Starlight Restaurant.

Day five and it's time to leave the beautiful Big Bend Country. Lunch will be in **Marathon** and then an afternoon stop at the **Judge Roy Bean Visitor's Center** in **Langtry**. Late afternoon we'll arrive at the border town of **Del Rio** and check into the Ramada Inn. After breakfast the morning of **Day six**, our first stop will be at the **First State Bank of Uvalde** for viewing of their art collection. Lunch near San Antonio followed by shopping at the **SAS Shoe Factory & General Store** where you may not only buy wholesale shoes and purses but, enjoy a 5 cent bag of popcorn and a 10 cent soda! These high-quality, fine leather shoes are not only made in the USA but proudly made in Texas.

What an extra special six day custom tour to the majestic **Big Bend Country** of Texas this will be. Every tour I've done to this area has left wonderful memories of the vastness and beauty found within our own great state. You won't want to miss this one!
